Vouvray and Savennierês are both made from the Chenin Blanc grape and are becoming more popular. I have fallen in love again with Viognier, great with cheese or just by itself. We offer three different ones and they all drink well. From Oregon comes the white pinot noir made by Domaine Serene in Oregon. When you close your eyes and smell, you would think it is a red pinot. From the tiny island of Santorini hails the Assyrtiko. You almost taste the Mediterranean and pairs well with any seafood.

TIMORASSO

Timorasso is one of the native white grapes from Piedmonte. It is a versatile grape with lots of minerality and freshness. Each winemaker manages to express different aspects of this grape. Sassaia is the only winery that ages in oak and taste more like a cru Burgundy. All others use stainless steel and it can show characteristics of chenin blanc or a dry riesling. It also ages very well, so do not be afraid to order the 2013 Fausto.

MERLOT AND MERLOT BLENDS

Merlot is finally making a comeback. Back in the day there was a lot of cheap merlot on the market, contributing to that bad reputation. Merlot can be every bit as powerful as Cabernet, but with a rounder and smoother finish.

RED BORDEAUX

The primary grapes in Bordeaux are Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. In general, Bordeaux Chateaus are split in either "Left" or "Right" bank, referring to the banks of the river in the town of Bordeaux. Blends from the "Left Bank" are more Cabernet Sauvignon based with other varieties added in. The "Right Bank" uses Merlot as the base for their blends. Famous right bank appellations are Saint Emillion and Pomerol. Known left bank towns are: Pauillac, St. Julien, St. Estephe and Margaux. We purchased some solid wines from the 2019 vintage from each bank, that will not break your "bank".
